New Tarrant County Criminal District Attorney's Office Policy Regarding Grand Jury Defense Presentations:

Code of Criminal Procedure Article 20.04 provides that defendants and their attorneys may only address the Grand Jury if approved by the State's attorney. Pursuant to that authority, the defense attorney will only be allowed to address the Grand Jury in the form of a sworn affidavit or affidavits, executed by a person or persons with personal knowledge of the facts alleged in the affidavits. The affidavits will be provided to the Grand Jurors when the case is presented by the State. Defendants wishing to testify may still do so.
